

TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY BOARD NOTES

December 6, 2017

Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m.

Ek moved to approve the November 8, 2017, minutes. Franke seconded and the motion unanimously passed.

Foss stated that the first public input session for the annual update of the Capital Improvements Program will be held on December 12, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Foss briefly explained the CIP process. He discussed adding the last section of Cooper Avenue South from Traverse Road to CSAH 75 and would like the Board to take a formal action recommendation of the project. This section would finish off the multi-modal system in the area. Another project that Foss would like to move forward is the 16th Street South connection to Roosevelt Road.

Ek questioned whether there were plans for a flashing yellow left turn at the intersection of Kilian Boulevard and University Drive SE. Foss stated that he would look into it.

Franke discussed information regarding the Bikeability Community Workshop. He would need a letter of support from a city representative and a Council member. Foss will get a letter to Franke.

Dirckx questioned the Cooper Avenue and University Drive corridor. Discussion ensued on this corridor.

Franke commented regarding the path/trail by Heritage Park along 2nd Street South. Discussion ensued regarding adding a trail/sidewalk to finish that section and development in the area.

Dirckx commented that 250th Street was rough. Foss stated that this area is listed in the Capital Improvements Program.

Franke moved to adjourn the meeting, Ek seconded and the motion unanimously passed. Meeting adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
