

TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY BOARD NOTES

March 14, 2018

Meeting called to order at 4:05 p.m. by Chair Daniel.

Franke moved to approve the January 10, 2018, minutes. Rindelaub seconded and the motion unanimously passed.

Foss noted that the 2019-2024 Capital Improvements Program was recently approved by the Planning Commission. Discussion ensued on the various projects.

Dirckx questioned the recent water main leak at 12th Street North and 33rd Avenue North. Foss stated the water mains are old and are cast iron pipe. Dirckx questioned what the City can/can't do in general with county roads and highways. Foss stated that the City can work together with them on a project but the City doesn't typically initiate projects.

Ludwig stated there were potholes on 1st Street North between 33rd and 34th Avenue North near Midtown Square. Ludwig also questioned if any work on Kilian Boulevard south of University Drive was planned. Foss stated that area is being planned for mill and overlay in 2021.

Rindelaub asked if there were any projects coming up that would have an impact on budget requests that would be related to any additional maintenance, such as the water main break. Foss stated that the type of emergency work/maintenance work that comes up is typically paid by other departments.

Franke mentioned he recently attended the Lake Street Council which is about bicycle friendly businesses where a business owner may share the cost with the City for bike racks. Franke commented that there is a Bike Summit in St. Paul tomorrow. Friday is Bus Operator Day.

Franke moved to adjourn the meeting. Ludwig seconded and the motion unanimously passed. Meeting adjourned at 4:40 p.m.
