

TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY BOARD NOTES

August 1, 2018

Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chair Rindelaub.

Franke moved to approve the July 11, 2018, minutes. Ludwig seconded and the motion unanimously passed.

Franke introduced Dave Broxmeyer with the Planning Department to discuss bike parking and bike rack inventory. Broxmeyer handed out a packet with inventory of various bike racks throughout downtown St. Cloud. It was discussed to possibly put a temporary bike rack near 1st Street South and 5th Avenue South to see if a permanent rack would be beneficial there. Broxmeyer commented that SCSU has bike racks the City could use. Broxmeyer stated that Allison with SHIP (State Health Improvement Partnership) may have grant money to be used for bike racks. It would need to be submitted by September. Rindelaub questioned which department would begin this process. Foss suggested going through Matt Glaesman, Planning Director. Franke made a motion to have staff confer with SHIP staff to see what funds are available. Motion was seconded by Ludwig and unanimously passed. Ludwig suggested using a Community Service Officer to see which bike racks are being used and which areas might be good spots to put additional racks.

Foss commented that he has been receiving complaints from residents questioning why their area is not in the current CIP. Foss also stated that projects keep getting extended into the future due to budget constraints. He has discussed this issue with administration. Discussion ensued on how to get more funding for projects.

Rindelaub questioned how often Board should meet and suggested meeting every other month. It was agreed upon by the Board to leave it up to staff to cancel a meeting if one is not needed. Rindelaub suggested not meeting in September. The next meeting will be held October 3, 2018.

Franke encouraged the Board to bike the new section of the Wobegon Trail.

Ek moved to adjourn meeting. Franke seconded. Meeting adjourned at 4:50 p.m.
