

# TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY BOARD NOTES

## December 5, 2018

Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chair Rindelaub.

Franke moved to approve the October 3, 2018, minutes. Rindelaub seconded and the motion unanimously passed.

Dirckx was invited to a Safe Routes to School meeting where they discussed different ideas such as doing a bike train, walking school bus, changing the drop off at North Junior High School and students cutting through the VA from the Westwood neighborhood to get to North Junior High school. Franke suggested that Allison Henning with the APO was a good contact for the SRTS program. Foss had also attended some of these meetings and stated that District 742 was the lead agency for the planning. Franke suggested that Henning possibly do a presentation to the Board when the report is done.

Discussion ensued on the City Bicycle Master Plan. Franke stated that St. Cloud was encouraged to use SHIP funds. These funds are only available until a certain date. Franke made a motion to ask the Planning Commission to fund a Bicycle Master Plan. Ludwig seconded the motion with an amendment to seek SHIP funds that are available. Motion passed unanimously.

Franke questioned the striping of bike lanes on 8th Street South and SCSU campus.

Ludwig asked about whether the 1st/2nd Street North project from the CIP was being done. Foss stated that the project got approved by the City Council but the project is only 1st Street North from 5th Avenue to the bridge. He commented that due to older utilities on the western portion of the original project, costs were too large.

Daniel questioned the timing of the traffic lights when buses are turning left. Foss referred him to discuss this issue with Blake Redfield, Traffic Systems Manager.

There was discussion on Board meeting dates. The Board decided to continue meeting every other month. Next meeting to be held on Wednesday, February 6, 2018.

Daniel moved to adjourn meeting. Franke seconded. Meeting adjourned at 4:50 p.m.
