

TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY BOARD NOTES

April 3, 2019

Meeting called to order at 4:03 p.m. by Chair Rindelaub.

Daniel moved to approve the February 6, 2019, minutes. Franke seconded and the motion unanimously passed.

Malikowski noted that Ek's term will expire on 4/30/19 and Theis' term will expire on 6/30/19. These are the only members expiring in 2019. Ek noted that she is willing to continue with the Board. Board discussed having Dircks as a voting member. Discussion ensued regarding Board membership terms.

Dircks questioned the No Right on Red signal at the intersection with Apollo High School and the VA. He noted that traffic turning right into the school gets backed up at the intersection. Foss stated he will check with Blake Redfield, Traffic Systems Manager.

Franke stated that the pedestrian call button stays lit up at night at the intersection of 12th Street North and 29th Avenue North.

Rindelaub asked how the City dealt with the flooding issues with the thaw. The City received multiple drainage complaints. Many residents also called to find where the catch basins were to help clear them and help with drainage.

Daniel stated that he would like to partner with Blake Redfield to discuss the TSP signals for the buses. A meeting will be set up to discuss.

Franke commented that May is bicycle month and that the City should be installing the new bike racks.
