

TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

August 5, 2015

Chairperson Ludwig called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Youngmann moved to approve the July 1, 2015, minutes. Ek seconded and the motion passed.

Dirckx reported that his Community Problem Solving project received second place at the International Competition.

Staff compiled a list of online submittals received from the past year for the Board's information. Discussion ensued regarding the online City submittals.

Foss stated that some of the 2016 neighborhood projects did not have support. The City is looking into doing surface rehabilitation projects such as 33rd Avenue North from TH 23 to 12th Street North and may extend it further depending on funding. He also noted that the 5th Avenue SE project was approved by the City Council and will be started in 2016. Foss stated that Northway Drive is still proposed for 2016 but has not gone to for City Council yet.

Youngmann questioned 8th Street North and 33rd Avenue North intersection. Foss stated that the work on 8th Street North/Veterans Drive is being done by Stearns County. Ludwig commented that the traffic light at 15th Avenue SE and TH 10 was not working properly. This will get reported to the Traffic Systems Department to forward to the correct agency. Franke commented that all of the bollards and some trees were taken care of on the trail. Dirckx commented that at TH 23 and 25th Avenue vehicles are coming out of the parking lot by Caribou and making an illegal u-turn instead of taking a driveway a little further away.

Daniel commented on the outcome of the MTC Wings & Wheels event.
