RE: Traffic Control Minimum

Temporary Traffic Control (TTC) is one of the most important aspects of the job site. We do require traffic control plans to be submitted for work on collector, minor and major arterial roads but side streets we do not. We are not planning to change this requirement; however, there is a minimum requirement for traffic control.

Please remember at least two Type Three Barricades (Type C channelizer devices) with a R11-2 "ROAD CLOSED" sign on each shall be used immediately adjacent to the work zone.



These two devices shall be combined with drums, posts or cones (preferably cones at least 28" high with retroreflective tape).

12" pylons shall not be used regardless.

In addition to the TTC devices, construction equipment should be parked in such a manner so as to further discourage traffic from attempting to enter and pass through the work zone.

Ideally you would use advanced warnings such as "W20-1" signs (ROAD WORK AHEAD) with placement being well in advance of your work zone and Type Three devices.
