When inspections schedule by an installer or contractor are preempted, prevented, or otherwise not able to be completed as scheduled due to circumstances beyond the control of the inspector, a supplemental inspection fee of \$50 per hour may be assessed in writing by the inspector.

525:45 Use of Specialized Equipment

The fire department may bill the property owner for the cost incurred for specialized equipment that is needed to successfully mitigate an incident.

525:50 Responses that exceed Eight (8) Hours

The fire department may bill the property owner for all incident costs incurred that exceed the first eight (8) hours of operations.
